

Re-opening our church buildings for Sunday worship

From 1st September, we will be re-starting Sunday services in our church buildings.

In order to keep you safe, we ask you to follow this guidance. In addition, each church has produced its own comprehensive risk assessment, which is available on request.

1. Use the hand sanitiser on entering and leaving the building
2. You do not need to sign in for the service but we will keep a record for 21 days of who attends in case there is a need for contact tracing
3. Help yourself to an order of service from the box near the entrance and place it in the second box at the end of the service
4. Please bring your own bible
5. Wear a face covering, unless you are exempt. This can be removed if you are leading any part of the service.
6. Follow the one-way system or the instructions of the person on duty
7. Please follow the 2metre social distancing requirements at all times
8. We cannot sing hymns – but there will be music!
9. Guidance for Holy Communion will be explained at the beginning of each service.
10. A collection will not be taken during the service but the offertory plate will be placed near the entrance for your contribution (alternatively, please consider making a regular donation by standing order)
11. Please do not come to the service if you have tested Covid positive or displayed Covid symptoms during the last 14 days!

This will inevitably feel very strange and not what we are used to but we come together to worship God – and he has never gone away!
